In addition to video lessons, the DVD contains our exclusive TNT 2 software that you can use to hear professional sound-alike recordings of every song in the book, alter the instrument and vocal mixes of the recordings for practice, loop playback, and change keys and tempos.

For installation, insert the DVD into a computer, double-click on **My Computer**, right-click on the CD drive icon, and select **Explore**. (Mac users can simply double-click the DVD icon that appears on the desktop.) Open the “**DVD-ROM Materials**” folder, then the “**TNT 2**” folder, and double-click on the installer file. Installation may take up to 15 minutes.



For your convenience, the included disc contains sound-alike and play-along MP3s of each song. These extras are in the “**DVD-ROM Materials**” folder—see the TNT 2 instructions at left to find that folder.
