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### Dynamics

Dynamic signs indicate how loudly or softly music should be played.


The symbol *f* forte—means: loud

The symbol *p* piano—means: soft

A crescendo  means: gradually get louder

A decrescendo  means: gradually get softer


 = repeat previous measure

 = whole rest = 4 beats of silence

### First and Second Endings

The repeat sign tells you to go back to the beginning. On the repeat, skip the first ending and play the second ending.

The Single Flammed Mill is a double stroke, with the first note flammed, followed by two single strokes.

## The Single Dragadiddle

The Single Dragadiddle is a double stroke followed by a tap, then by a double stroke.

The Flam Drag is a flam followed by a double stroke, then by a single stroke.
