Clowning Around

When the circus comes to town, one of the main attractions for "children of all ages" is the clowns. Their humorous antics always get the show rolling and they frequently move through the audience with their happy and sometimes sad faces.

Clowning Around is a delightful composition that reflects on both personalities of the circus clowns. The opening Allegro is bouncy and cheerful, set in the Lydian mode (major scale with a sharp fourth degree). A brief transition leads to a more reflective alto saxophone solo that develops into a lovely chorale-style section before returning to the happy-go-lucky opening first theme and a light-hearted ending.
