Performance Notes

This piece has been arranged so that the Marimba 1 and Marimba 2 parts can be performed on the same instrument without collisions (although there are a few tight spots that may call for editing, depending on the size of your players). If available, it is recommended that two marimbas are used. Unlike many arrangements in this series, the bass part is independent of Marimba 2 and is therefore required (and not optional). There are a few three-mallet sections for the vibraphone, but the part is repetitive and would serve as an excellent, attainable introduction to a multiple-mallet grip. If desired, the part can easily be edited for two mallets by eliminating one of the voices in the chords. The drumset player will need to play sleigh bells on *Happy Xmas*. Toward that end, it is recommended that the player place a folded towel on the floor tom to function as a “pad” for the sleigh bells to strike in order to play the rhythms. There are also transitions back to sticks, and then back to sleigh bells for the end of the piece that will need to be addressed individually and could possibly create edits in the drumset part.

* Sleigh Bells
in Right Hand

* The sleigh bells, along with a towel, should be on a music stand or trap table near the floor tom. In measure 25, drop the right stick, pick-up the sleigh bells from the table (by the handle in your right hand), and begin to shake them (roll) all in one gesture. The sleigh bells should be perpendicular to the ground with the handle up, and held with the right hand (grabbing it like a baseball bat). The fermata will facilitate the transition, allowing you to move the towel in place on top of the floor tom with the left hand. Beginning at measure 26, begin striking the sleigh bells on the towel (now on top of the floor tom) so the eighth notes are clearly articulated.
