Named Poetry Consultant of the Library of Congress from 1950-52, Aiken earned numerous prestigious national writing awards over his lifespan, including a National Book Award, the Bollingen Prize in Poetry, the National Institute of Arts and Letters Gold Medal, the National Medal for Literature, and the Poetry Society of America Shelley Memorial Award.
