NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Some fun facts: A “polar vortex” is a large pocket of very cold air, typically the coldest, that sits over the arctic region of North America during the winter. The polar vortex is not a new phenomenon, as scientists have been studying it for many decades. What really happens is that every now and then, areas of high pressure displace this mass of cold air over the Pacific, pushing the colder air south over Canada and into the upper regions of the United States.

Now to the music. The introduction sets the mood for the siren-like sound at m. 5, followed by a thematic funk bass unison motive, played by the bass, guitar, and piano, that leads to the unison melody at m. 13. Up to that point, the music anticipates the arrival of something—the “polar vortex.”

At m. 21, the mood changes, as the melodic line is now harmonized in fourths to give the harmony an edgy, cool sound. Then the siren-like effect returns, and musical intensity begins to develop as the unison melody returns.

At m. 42, the solo section includes a written alto sax solo. The soloist can play as written or embellish some improvisational ideas. If desired, other soloists could play in this solo section.

When programming this work, adding an actual siren/alarm sound effect will certainly enhance the dramatic effectiveness of the piece. You are encouraged to experiment with the following idea:

Have a couple of students research the Internet for a siren/alarm-like sound effect application (app).

Download the app to a Smart Phone or Tablet.

Once the download is completed, play the siren/alarm sound through a sound system or small amplifier so that it is heard, but make certain the sound is not distorted and does not drown out the ensemble. With a little practice, this approach should come off smoothly and effectively.

To make this activity even more fun, get the audience involved by inviting the school principal, a parent, or a community leader to play the sound effect. This person would not have to read music; just cue the sound effect as needed.
