Performance Notes for THE SERVANT SONG: Particularly useful for dedication services or any servant-emphasis service, this fresh setting of The Servant Song is also useful for general worship all year long. Pay careful attention to the subtle tempo and dynamic changes that serve to underscore the heartfelt, yet powerful text. Consider congregational involvement from measures 52-69. Take your time from measures 72 to the end, letting the final message of the song fully resonate
