The Gift of Perfect Peace is based on Isaiah 26:3. The gift is promised to those who place their complete trust in the Lord. The anthem may be sung at any time in a worship service, but may be especially effective just before a time of silence. The choir and instrumentalists should work to make the piece "serene" and unhurried.

Mary Kay Beall has written texts for hundreds of anthems and many extended works both sacred and secular. She often writes with her husband and creative partner, composer John Carter. Mary Kay is an ordained minister in the United Church of Christ and the former Pastor of Tree of Life Community Church in Columbus, Ohio.

Claude L. Bass lives in Fort Worth, Texas. In 2001 he retired from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary as Distinguished Professor of Music Theory and Composition.
