

The melody of "Ave Marist" was originally written by French composer Charles Gounod (1818-1893 a a a solo for violin, using an accompaniment originally written by Johan<ebastian Bach (1685-1): "Prelude No. 1 in C major" for piano (clavier). The Latin text was adder rater, and in the years side, Gounod's piece has become one of the most poplar settings of "Ave Mari""
