PROGRAM NOTES

Composed by The Who's guitarist Peter (Pete) Townshend and recorded by the iconic rock band, "You Better You Bet" was originally released on their 1981 album, *Face Dances*. Written as a love song for his girlfriend, Townshend's melody and lyrics have become one of the band's most popular songs.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

The percussion 1 part can be assigned to two players (player 1—hi-hat cymbals/snare drum/tom-tom; player 2—bass drum), or one player could play drumset. There is also an optional electric bass part which doubles the tuba.

Throughout the arrangement, care should be taken not to overshadow the melody, particularly in measures 29–40 and 51–58, where the alto and tenor saxophones and horns should shine through. Students should be mindful of the tenuto and staccato markings throughout the arrangement, especially in measures 73–76.
