ABOUT THE COMPOSER

Stephen Bulla received his degree in arranging and composition from Boston's *Berklee College of Music*, graduating Magna Cum Laude. His studies there developed an interest in the commercial writing field, eventually leading to the present schedule of full time composing.

In 1980 Mr. Bulla joined "The President's Own" U.S. Marine Band and White House Orchestra as Staff Arranger. As such he is responsible for the production of music that encompasses many styles and instrumental combinations, most of which are performed for Presidential functions and visiting dignitaries. His musical arrangements for many performers including Sarah Vaughan, The Manhattan Transfer, Mel Torme, and Doc Severinsen were featured on the PBS television series "In Concert At The White House". He has also produced orchestrations for Marvin Hamlisch, Joe Raposo, and jazz pianist Dick Hyman. A diversity of commercial projects find Mr. Bulla in the studio frequently

producing CD recordings, as well as writing music for regional and national advertising campaigns with a variety of clients. In 1990 he was awarded the prestigious ADDY Award for best original music/TV spot.

His commissioned concert works include instrumental compositions that are performed and recorded internationally. The Dutch, British and New Zealand Brass Band Championship organizations have all commissioned test pieces from his pen. His wind band compositions are published exclusively at present by CMP (North America) and De Haske Music (Europe).

Stephen Bulla is a member of ASCAP (American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers) and has received that organization's Performance Award annually since 1984.

With a growing catalog of works published and recorded in the U.S. and abroad Mr. Bulla travels frequently as a guest conductor, adjudicator and clinician. He also serves as music director for The Salvation Army National Capital Brass Band (Washington D.C.).

PROGRAM NOTES:

This light-hearted piece features the saxophone section, with the rest of the band in accompaniment. It is written in the style of the ragtime and flapper period music of the early twentieth century. Perhaps you will be transported back in time as you listen and imagine the era of silent movies and slapstick comedy.

NOTE TO THE CONDUCTOR:

The entire score is written in a swing style. Be sure that the full band understands the appropriate treatment of consecutive eighths so the style is consistent. Also, the music should be conducted in two throughout.

Strict adherence to written dynamics will produce the proper balance between band and the saxophone soloists. For example, the accompaniment at section 9 should remain subdued until the band takes over at section 25.

Section 44 will provide contrast both dynamically and through the composer's choice of a darker key. Thorough rehearsal will insure a comfort zone in all four flats for the concert pitch instruments. At bar 50 the muted brass (with upper woodwinds) can exaggerate the short, staccato punctuation.

In the final section each saxophone part has a two bar solo (see bars 106-113). Rehearse the soloists here to imitate sound and style as well as blend in the ensuing harmonized soli section at measure 114. In all cases have fun with the music.







