

Finding your way from the music



- Music is written on a stave or staff.
 It has five lines with four spaces in between.
- 2 Notes are written on the **lines** or in the **spaces**.



- 3 High notes are written in the **treble clef**. (Right hand.)
- 4 Middle C has its very own line.
 In the treble clef it is below the stave.





5 The right hand plays high notes.

Hold up your right hand.


Point to your 3rd finger.

Point to your 1st finger.

Point to your 5th finger.

Point to your 2nd finger.

Point to your 4th finger.





If two notes of the same pitch are joined by a curve







this is called a TIE.


Play the first note and hold it on for the value of the second note.
