*Piano Progress* provides a graded sequence of pieces by master composers ranging from Bach to Bartók.

Here is a well tested, diverse repertoire for the pianist who has begun to master a basic technique. Alongside the solo pieces there are duets, which will provide a welcome opportunity for players to enjoy making music with others.


