

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756-1791) wastone of the most notables posers of the Viennese Classical style. In Mozart's time, a Miss brevis (brief Mass) wa quite concise and few ingonments were employed, since it was composed for use in the ma no worship service of the Catholic Church. Mozart originally stored the Agnus Lei of this trass for S.A.T.B. voices with an accompaniment of strings and continuo.
This edition includes a keyboard reduction of the instrumental parts as the accompaniment Modern refs, tempo and dynamic indications and an English person of the original Lathe art have $\Omega \theta$ been added by the editor. An edition of this\& Chorus for SAB. voices is also available (5835).
