NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

A rock-solid tempo, rhythmic drive, and accurate articulation are key elements for performing this rhumba successfully. At measure 12, trombones should keep the important background figure tight, clean, and energized. The melody played by the trumpets in measure 29 should offer a legato phrasing contrast. The eighths played by the trombones and rhythm in measure 20 should be played even, not swung.

Whenever the ensemble and sections play together, the phrasing should include releases: for example, remind the trumpet section to release together on beat 3 in measure 30. This will set the style for the other sections to follow. The interlude at measure 37 must be phrased together as each section joins in. Observe the upbeat accents in measure 40.

The rhythm section has plenty of repetition, but this is what gives the chart drive. Focus on keeping the energy flowing. An auxiliary percussion player can add tremendously to this Latin groove, but if multiple players are used, caution the tendency to overplay.
